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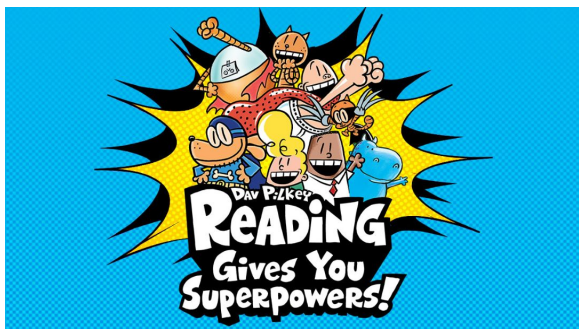
## Watch Authors Read Their Own Books



It's always fun to hear an author read their own story! Take a look at many of the read-aloud options listed [here](#)! There are three sections including Elementary, Middle, and High School.

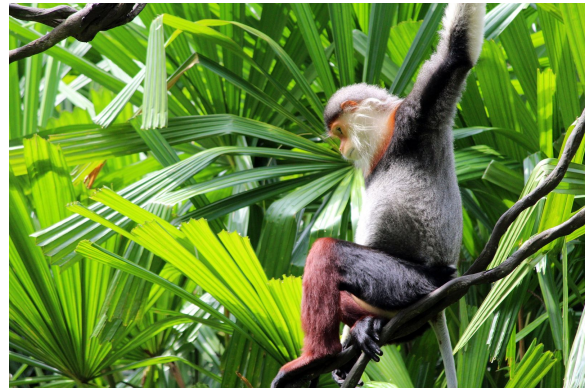
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## Try Dav Pilkey's Free Activities
